Part-time program description

The General Education Division, through the English Opens Doors Program (EODP), recruits English native or almost native speakers to work as a part-time volunteer with Chilean English teachers in public schools throughout the country.

The part-time program is an initiative for international students within Chilean universities. A volunteer from this program cooperates with a minimum amount of four (4) and sixteen (16) hours per week, supporting English teachers in the speaking and listening skills development as an English native (or almost native) speaker.

The EODP does not require that international students interested in the program have a degree or experience on education, since their work is to support the class work developed by the English teacher.

How it works?

1. Through Chilean universities, the EODP provides information to international students, inviting them to apply.
2. The EODP gives a presentation to inform and motivate the exchange students.
3. The EODP trains exchange students and teachers who will participate in this program to implement teaching-learning strategies in the class.
4. The EODP assigns the exchange students according to their availability and their campus/residence location.
5. The EODP follows up with teachers and volunteers regularly to ensure a smooth and successful implementation.

Benefits for the volunteers (international students):

- Live a volunteering experience abroad, making a social contribution to the community and to public education.
- Learn about Chilean culture while you work with children/teenagers.
- Share your own culture in your daily work.
- Discover education as a possible vocation.
- Obtain a diploma from the Ministry of Education of Chile, which certifies your volunteering work.
- Have access to an E-Learning Spanish course.
- The chance to take the international Spanish exam BULATS, for volunteers who complete a minimum of 40 volunteering hours per month.

Benefits for the receiver establishments:

- Boost English learning in public and semi-private schools.
- Their students can have the opportunity to practice their English in a dynamic way.
- A cultural exchange between people from other countries and the local community.
- The opportunity to listen and repeat a native (or almost native) pronunciation.
- The opportunity for the teachers to practice their English.
- Increase motivation and interest within the students to learn English.
